Dear Customer:

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) adopted regulations to implement the Public Health Security and Bioterrorism Preparedness and Response Act of 2002 (The Bioterrorism Act) and as of December 12, 2003, all food facilities be registered and that notice be given to the FDA before foods are imported. The FDA Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA) enacted January 4, 2011 amended the food facility registration requirements in section 415 of the FD&C Act. All Tree Top facilities are individually registered, and current with the biennial registration requirements. Tree Top has also confirmed that all of our suppliers, where applicable, have complied with the registration requirements as outlined.

In the Bioterrorism Act, Congress directed the FDA to keep registration information confidential for security reasons. At Tree Top, Inc., we respect that decision and in the spirit of cooperation with government efforts to assure the safety of the food supply, we have determined that we must keep our facility registration information confidential. Therefore, we will not ask for your registration information either.

In order to protect our mutual business interests, please make sure that your company fully complies with all aspects of the Bioterrorism Act of 2002 and FSMA enacted amendments.
